MAYOR RORY

Hold on a Whole Foods minute!
"Elderberry," "Mocha," "Kiwi"?

CINDY

Like, I mean it. The Badger People really think about food a lot. They gave the colored spheres, like, names that match foods.

MAYOR RORY

This conversation is making me hungry. Fun fact: several parts of a Mayor's desk are edible. Continue.

CINDY

Like, the Purple spheres are Elderberry. They're the first ones I found.

SOUND: CRACKLE AS MAYOR RORY TAKES A BITE OUT OF HIS DESK.

SOUND: GRINDING OF WOOD AS CINDY CONTINUES TO SPEAK.

CINDY (cont'd)

They're sort of like giant glow-in-thedark beach balls that light up The Tunnels. They also, like, absorb sound.

DERRICK

They're the ones that make music, right?

CINDY

Like, right on. The next ones, the "Mocha" ones, can roll around on their own. They look for, like, energy. The first one I saw drained the batteries on Princess.

MAYOR RORY

(swallowing)

Not cool!

CINDY

Like, they dump the power into The Tunnel's energy grid.

DERRICK

I'm beginning to get the picture.

CINDY

And then we found the, like, "Kiwi" spheres. They can also move around by themselves. They suck up moisture and, (MORE)

CINDY (cont'd)

like, put it into the water supply for The Tunnels.

DERRICK

This certainly does explain the power and water problems we've been having around town. I don't think we have a choice, Mayor. We have to shut those tunnels down.

CINDY

Like, whoa! Hold on, man. Chillax a second. I might have, found something that will, like, solve all this.

MAYOR RORY

(still munching a tiny bit)

Is it another fruit and or vegetablenamed sphere?

CINDY

Like, no.

MAYOR RORY

Good.

(swallows)

I'm not feeling hungry anymore.

CINDY

Like, this one is a golden-colored sphere. The Badger People called it "Waffle Batter."

MAYOR RORY

Batter up!

DERRICK

Another sphere! How can that help?

CINDY

Romeo wrote that he was worried about the spheres. He didn't think the Badger People understood the, like, dangers. So he asked them to make one more.

MAYOR RORY

That's crazy. If I break my Harlan Ellison action figure, I don't break my Stephen King one to fix it.

CINDY

Romeo said the Waffle Batter sphere can, quote -- control the other sphere types and take them to the next level -- unquote.

DERRICK

You think this Waffle Batter sphere can solve the problem?

CINDY

Like, yeah.

MAYOR RORY

All right. I can give you 72 hours to fix this, Cindy. But, if you can't, I'm (MORE)

going to need you to turn in your badge and your gun.

CINDY

(puzzled)

Like, okay? Thank you, Mayor. I'll, like, get to work. Like, goodbye.

SOUND: FOOTSTEPS.

SOUND: DOOR OPENS AND CLOSES.

MAYOR RORY

Wow. That was crazy, right?

DERRICK

It sure was. A Waffle Batter sphere that controls Elderberries, Mocha and Kiwi?

MAYOR RORY

No. Not that, brother. I mean that we didn't get a musical number.

DERRICK

Oh. Are you going to sing now?

MAYOR RORY

Nah. I'll just hum along with the transition sting.

MAYOR RORY hums along with the music.

MUSIC: SHORT TRANSITION STING.

CHAPTER 5, SCENE 2: INT. GEN. KALAMITY'S OFFICE - DAY

NARRATOR

Meanwhile, at Camp Parmenter, the small base General Kalamity has established in Middling Fair, the General is in his office, speaking with a subordinate.

KALAMITY

Soldier, what's the status on Operation: Bus Buster?

SOLDIER

(uncomfortable with the name, since he thinks of the bus as a human)

Sir, I really wish we could come up with a better name for this project.

KALAMITY

(also unhappy about the project)

Yeah. I hear you. I asked Washington for alternatives.

SOUND: RUSTLE OF PAPER.

KALAMITY (cont'd)

"Operation: Transport Tear Down"?
"Operation: KRULR Killer"? "Operation:
Bus Salad Surgery"?

SOLDIER

All winners, sir. (MORE)

SOLDIER (cont'd)

(sighs)

I'm actually done. I hooked up the new batteries to the solar collectors on the bus. Cindy just has to drive Princess out of The Tunnels every few weeks to keep them charged. So, as soon as Captain Broughha and his team finish up, Princess will be set to be decommissioned.

KALAMITY

Outstanding, soldier. Look, I know that, as cool as our new KRAWLR is, that old bus is something special. I wish there was...

SOUND: KNOCK ON OFFICE DOOR.

KALAMITY (cont'd)

Come...

SOUND: DOOR OPENS.

KALAMITY (cont'd)

In. Ah, Captain Broughha, We were just talking about you.

Captain **BROUGHHA** is an officer in his late 30's. he is as focused on his duties as Kalamity was when he first arrived in middling fair. training has sharpened Broughha to a razor's edge. He sees nothing other than the mission and only looks out for the welfare of his elite task force, known as the Magenta Fedoras.

BROUGHHA

Permission to speak freely, sir. (MORE)

BROUGHHA (cont'd)

(finally noticing SOLDIER)

In private.

SOLDIER

That's okay. I have cleanup work to do in The Tunnels, sirs.

KALAMITY

Very well. Dismissed, soldier.

SOUND: DOOR OPENS.

SOUND: DOOR CLOSES

KALAMITY (cont'd)

Now, Broughha, what's on your mind? Obviously not procedure.

BROUGHHA

Sir, those new security protocols you have in place over at The Tunnels are making work for my Magenta Fedoras difficult.

KALAMITY

(quietly pleased)

Really? And what work is that, exactly?

BROUGHHA

The same as always, sir. My team was tasked with delivering the KRAWLR to you and then decommissioning the KRULR.

KALAMITY

And you, and the rest of your Magenta Fedoras, have been here for months! My man says his work on Princess, uh, the KRULR, is done. And he's just one man. What's taking the three of you so long?

BROUGHHA

For one thing, sir, that sad bucket needs a lot of work done to it.

KALAMITY

I see. Go on.

BROUGHHA

And we have not been able to locate the special PH98 Philips-head screwdriver that was entrusted to us for this assignment. A good soldier never leaves a tool behind.

KALAMITY

I can believe that you know a thing or two about tools.

BROUGHHA

Thank you, sir. In addition, the town Rabbi has not responded to my request to attend the impending decommissioning to certify it as kosher for Passover.

KALAMITY

All very reasonable excuses, of course.

BROUGHHA

While my team powers through them, I would like to, again, sir, formally request the opportunity to examine the sphere documentation that the civilian, Cindy, has in her possession. Sir, the power of those spheres could be of great value to the military.

KALAMITY

And, every time I've made your request, Captain, Cindy has declined. I can't force her to share the information.

BROUGHHA

(very frustrated)

Yes, sir.

KALAMITY

Why don't you relax a bit, Captain?
Maybe you and the rest of the Fedoras
should go into town and take in a movie?

BROUGHHA

Yes, sir. Is there anything else, sir?

KALAMITY

(giving up)

No. That will be all. Dismissed.

BROUGHHA

Yes, sir. Thank you, sir.

SOUND: DOOR OPENS.

SOUND: DOOR CLOSES.

KALAMITY

(to himself)

Why do I get the feeling that he's hiding something?

CHAPTER 5, SCENE 3: EXT. OFFICER'S HQ - CONTINUOUS

SOUND: DISTANT TRAFFIC FROM THE NEARBY STREETS OF MIDDLING FAIR.

NARRATOR

Meanwhile, outside.

BROUGHHA

Go see a movie? Kalamity is clearly not taking this seriously. I'm going to get those books, as I promised General Disarray, no matter what. Perhaps I should walk off some of this frustration.

BROUGHHA WALKS IN MARCHING TIME.

BROUGHHA (cont'd)

(singing in a marching drill cadence)

Why won't they let me
Why won't they let me
Why won't they let me just have those
books?

(MORE)

BROUGHHA (cont'd)

I am just doing
I am just doing
Doing my job and a little bit more.

SOUND: MORE SETS OF FEET HAVE BEEN JOINING IN.

CHORUS OF VOICES

Why won't they let you

SOUND: FOOTSTEPS STOP.

BROUGHHA

(speaking)

Who was that?

(silence)

Apparently no one.

SOUND: FOOTSTEPS RESUME.

BROUGHHA (cont'd)

(back to marching drill
 cadence)

I want out of this one horse hick town.

CHORUS OF VOICES

You slowed down work just to stick around.

BROUGHHA

I had no choice, I have work to do.

GENERAL DISARRAY WILL BE REFERRED TO AS GENERAL "DISMAY" FOR THE REST OF THE SONG. THIS WILL PLAY OUT MORE LATER IN THE STORY.

CHORUS OF VOICES

Or General "Dismay" will bust you.

BROUGHHA

But no one here will help my mission.

CHORUS OF VOICES

You mean the one that's your addition?

BROUGHHA

I boasted that I'd get those books out.

CHORUS OF VOICES

You gave your word and left zero doubt.

BROUGHHA

General "Dismay" is waiting.

CHORUS OF VOICES

So get those books or be berated.

BROUGHHA

CHORUS OF VOICES

BROUGHHA

CHORUS OF VOICES

BROUGHHA

(noticing other footsteps are gone)

(pause, then speaking, far less sure of himself)

Sound off. One. Two?

SOUND: FOOTSTEPS STOP.

CHIEF

Sir, were you talking to someone?

BROUGHHA

(pulling it together)

No, Chief. There is no one here but me. As you were.

CHIEF

Yes, sir.
