SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES OFF.

SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES ON.

CINDY (OVER RADIO)

Like, right on. $\underline{I'm}$ listening. What's up?

SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES OFF.

SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES ON.

KALAMITY

Based on the information you gave us, it appears that the swarm of artists following you has turned off the highway to refuel. What is your situation? Over.

SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES OFF.

SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES ON.

CINDY (OVER RADIO)

Like, Detective Haartte is driving right now.

(to HAARTTE)

Like, do we need to stop for gas?

HAARTTE (OVER RADIO)

(loudly, back to CINDY)

How should I know?! Too many buttons and dials! It's like trying to fly the Millennium Enterprise! As near as I can (MORE)

HAARTTE (OVER RADIO) (cont'd)

tell, the batteries are at 82 percent, we have plenty of windshield washer fluid and we haven't even touched the gas backup.

CINDY (OVER RADIO)

Like, Detective Haartte said, like, "No."

SOUND: WALKIE-TALKIE CRACKLES OFF.

SOUND KNOCK ON STUDIO DOOR.

BUZZ

Who could that be? Come in.

SOUND: DOOR OPENS.

BUZZ (cont'd)

Mayor Rory!

MAYOR RORY

In person. And I believe you Derrick.

BUZZ

Uh, yeah. We all do.

MAYOR RORY

See, brother? I told you.

BUZZ

What's an important person like you doing in a tunnel like this, Mayor?

MAYOR RORY

I've come to see if you've found that Waffle Batter sphere.

BUZZ

Not yet, Mr. Mayor. Cindy and Detective Haartte are on a hot lead. They're on their way to Niagara Falls right now.

MAYOR RORY

I see.

Pause.

DERRICK

Rory, aren't you going to make some clever remarks about any of this?

MAYOR RORY

No.

DERRICK

(to BUZZ and KALAMITY)

The Mayor's been under a lot of pressure over the power and water problem the spheres down here are causing. It's starting to affect his state of mind.

MAYOR RORY

When we get back to town hall, Derrick, we should go over the budget projections for the rest of the fiscal year.

KALAMITY

I didn't realize it was that bad up there.

DERRICK

It is. In fact, just this afternoon over at the Venus Arms...

MUSIC: HARP GLISSANDO DOWN.

CHAPTER 17, SCENE 2: VENUS ARMS HOTEL LOBBY - FLASHBACK

CAP

It's about time we made another appearance in this thing!

GILES

Cap? Who are you talking to? Oh, never mind. We have a guest checking into the Venus Arms this afternoon. I want the hotel to be in top shape.

CAP

I'm doing the best I can to fill your wacky, offbeat shoes, Mayor Rory. It isn't easy. Let's get this crisis resolved, people!

CHAPTER 17: OUTRO

NARRATOR

Now we have to worry about Mayor Rory, too? I'm going to need a scorecard to keep track of all this. While I go get one, you be sure to come back for Chapter 18, "This Stop Is The Pits".
